Dear Parents,

All the Sisters join me in wishing you and your family a very happy and blessed Eid. We know how difficult and disappointing it has been not to be able to celebrate fully because of all the restrictions, as a result of the continuing danger of Covid-19, but we all know that these are imposed for our safety. I am writing to update you on some decisions that the management and staff have made recently. We had hoped that school would re-open on Monday 17th, but now due to a further closure, we feel that we have to move on, since the month of May will almost be at an end by the time school re-starts, hopefully on Monday May 24th.

Since October 01st 2020, when our girls returned to school, we have been carrying out an assessment programme, just in case school had to close again. As you know, the Final term examinations were to start on March 15th, the same day schools were closed again. The assessment we did was based on small tests at the end of chapters completed and class work and home work was also graded.

Both students and staff feel that it is time to start new work. They have been in the same class since last March, even though they did not attend school as such. But online teaching has gone on the whole year and even revision of all the subjects has reached its limit. So, in view of this scenario, we have decided to base promotion to the next class on the year's work, even though it has been a very broken year. Reports will be given out to all the students next week, starting from Monday 17th. The giving out of the results will be as follows:-

I request you, dear parents, to kindly see that your children will be very punctual according to the above timings, because we do not want any overcrowding in the school. Reports will not be given to anyone outside of the above timings. All SOPs must be strictly followed. Thank you. You will receive the book lists via WhatsApp. If possible, try not to buy new books, but take from sisters, cousins, friends etc, because in August we will start using the books of the SNC (Single National Curriculum). Classes 6, 7 and 8 will buy their new books, as the SNC does not apply to them for now.
